

2022 City of Cortez Clean-Up Week

Monday – Friday, May 16-20, 2022

The City of Cortez will have **CURBSIDE** pick-up only, **NO DROP-OFF DAY WILL BE HELD.**

- Use your polycart for household trash and leave it in the usual location for trash pick-up.
- Put loose items in a container.
- **BAG IT, BOX IT, TIE IT UP...PLEASE!**
- **YARD WASTE MUST BE BAGGED** and placed at the curb, not in the alley. Branches must be cut into 4' lengths and bundled.
- **CONTRACTOR WASTE WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.**

Put your trash AT THE CURB, not in the front yard and not in the alley.

NO TIRES AT ALL!!!

Tires will not be picked up. Contact Big-O, 4-States, or Wal-Mart for tire disposal.



NO MATTRESSES!!!



There will be no chipper service this year, but we will pick branches up curbside. Branches must be cut no longer than 4' and bundled together for curbside pickup.
