



Brownfield Site Nomination Form

In 2022, the Colorado Department of Public Health & Environment (CDPHE) and the cities of Cortez, Firestone, Longmont, and Lyons were awarded a \$2,000,000 U.S. EPA (EPA) Brownfields grant to support the assessment, cleanup planning, and revitalization of publicly and privately-owned underutilized properties (sites). Grant funds can be used to complete Phase I and II Environmental Site Assessments (ESAs), cleanup planning, and a variety of property reuse planning activities. Funding will be available for use on a first come, first served basis likely through summer 2027, for approximately 30 high priority Phase I ESA sites and 18 high priority Phase II ESA sites.
