CITY MANAGER'S REPORT

September 10, 2024

Mayor and Council:

The following is my report for the current term:

- The CDOT Traffic Engineering School Study for South Broadway and West Main St. have resulted in the recommendation that a 'school zone' be installed near the Montezuma Cortez Middle School from mile post 37.68 to 38.07 with a 25 mph school zone speed limit, along with changes to speed zones near the middle school and improved pedestrian crossings in the area.
- The City is now offering Bear Deterrent Poly Carts equipped with a securable lid. They will adhere to the same guidelines as regular poly carts, and must be unfastened when set out for pickup.
- Detective Lieutenant Ryan Loyd has officially retired from the Cortez Police Department after twenty and a half years of service to his community. His last day will be Thursday September 12, 2024. Lieutenant Loyd joined the Cortez Police Department in March, 2004 as a patrol officer, was promoted to Detective in March, 2010, and then promoted to Detective Lieutenant in February, 2015. The City of Cortez would like to thank Lieutenant Loyd for his many years of dedication and service to our community.
